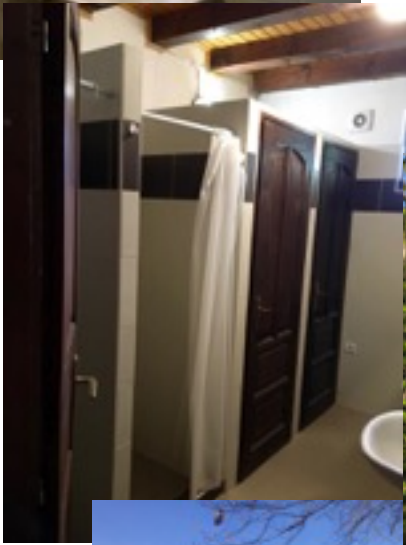

Location -Mailáthpuszta:

The settlement is located in the southern part of Baranya County in Ormánság region, one of the most disadvantaged areas of the country, close of to the Croatian border along the Dráva river, about 25 km from Siklós (town), 50 km from Pécs (one of the biggest cities). Specific for the place is the water rich environment. The Dráva river, the Black Water, the lake of Mailáthpuszta and lake Kísszentmárton can be found here.

Forgotten knowledge of local plants, hand made natural products, DIY and modern technology

4 WORKSHOPS:

- “DIY” - *renovate old fishing piers and build fishing hut from recycled materials at lake Mailathpuszta*
- “Plant book” – *recipes and photos of different plants, flowers, leaves*
- “Media” – *short videos, basic skills of video making*
- “Making natural products” - *from plants (cream, tea, cleaning products, soap)*

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

“Save Nature for Safe Future” project will be the 9th large youth exchange in history of Sustainable Ormánság Nonprofit Ltd. The venue of the exchange will be lake Mailathpuszta again like last summer. We would like to help the local community and fishermen's association with some of our DIY activities. We are planning to renovate old fishing piers which are ruined and build some fishing huts from recycled materials. We would like to create an album to identify and collect different type of local leaves plants and flowers with a help of local experts. We think it is important to know about the different uses of the plants that we can easily find in our own gardens or in nature, for medicine, cosmetics, soap and cleaning products or just try to them as infusions. Meanwhile we will record and document all of our activities during the program, making photos short videos and disseminate project results on different social media channels to reach a wider audience. We will use non-formal educational methods and experience pedagogy to build the program. Our project supports sustainable development and social economy also foster intercultural dialogue. Four different creative workshops will give tangible knowledge for participants and support employability and creative entrepreneurship. We would like raise awareness protecting environment and using global learning methods. Our project is connected to the European Year of Cultural Heritage in 2018 and we would like to join that initiative because in our project the past meets the future. Participants are going to live in a guest house and holiday homes made of recycled containers, commute by bike and explore rural lifestyle. In between we are going to focus on current topics of EU, like Euroscepticism, climate change, water pollution, sustainable transportation, socio-economic situation of EU, protection of European heritage, solidarity and social inclusion in Europe. We would like to bring closer all these topics to the local people also for better understanding of unity in diversity concept.
